



OCSA names Cayleb Paulino 2023 Women's Coach of the Year

Cayleb Paulino, Head Women's Soccer Coach at Ashland University, has been named the 2023 Ohio Collegiate Soccer Association (OCSA) Women's Coach of the year. Paulino led the Eagles to a historic 19-1-4 overall record and 11-0-3 mark in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference.

The Eagles finished the season ranked 10th in the country and were the top-ranked team for six weeks this fall, and were No. 2 for three more. This is the second-highest season-ending ranking in program history, only behind the 2004 squad which finished its campaign seventh in the nation.

The Eagles ran thru the regular season with a 17-0-4 record and moved thru the first two rounds of the NCAA tournament with home wins against Michigan Tech and Cedarville before falling to Grand Valley in the Sweet Sixteen match up. For his efforts Paulino and his staff were honored as the United Soccer Coaches Division II Region Staff of the Year.

The Ohio Collegiate Soccer Association, founded in 1953, includes all divisions of College Soccer in Ohio with a membership over 100 Men's and Women's Soccer programs.
